## Registration Policy

Those that pre-register by May 15th will be guaranteed a space in case we reach capacity on the first day of camp. Pre-registering only requires that each camper mail in the camp registration sheet not a payment.

## Camp Policy

Please be advised that snacks are not to be brought to camp. The Department of Public Health Rules do not allow food in the sleeping areas. Also all campers are required to have a fitted sheet for their twin mattress.

This is a Christian camp, therefore all rules, responsibilities and standards of Christian modesty, dress and behavior will apply.

In order to conform with our insurance regulations, we must inform each camper, and parent/legal guardian that no child will be permitted to leave, or leave and return to the campground facilities without expressed written permission of the parent/legal guardian. They must also be signed out by a parent/legal guardian. Some form of ID may be required. This is for the safety of the children, which is our first concern.

We ask that you not call to speak with your child during camp, unless it is an emergency. Likewise campers are not permitted to call home except in emergencies.

Upon arrival at camp, everyone is required to first sign in at the office and receive instructions for check in. All campers must have a signed camp registration form or they will not be permitted on the campgrounds.

Letters mailed to the campers will be promptly delivered to them.
